UNCP Emergency Eyewash/Safety Shower Weekly Inspection Checklist

Prior to flushing the eyewash and safety shower stations, check for the following:

- Is the area around the station clear of obstructions?
- Are the dust caps/covers over the eyewash nozzles in place?

Please insure that a bucket is used to capture water from the station during the test and clean up any spilled water. Place a wet floor sign on the floor if required.

To test the eyewash:

- Depress the paddle until water flows. The water should remain flowing after you remove your hand from the paddle.
- Continue to flow water until the water is clear with no indication of rust, dirt, etc. for 10-15 seconds.
- Feel the water to make sure it is tepid (room temperature not hot or cold).

To test the safety shower:

• Pull the handle of the safety shower and flow water for 15-20 seconds. The water should flow without the handle having to be held.
