



Quick Reference Guide

Curricular Requirements:

End-of-The Year GPA Requirements

- First Year: 3.0
- Second Year: 3.25
- Third Year: 3.4
- Fourth or Final Year: 3.4

Honors college students will successfully complete at least 22 hours of honors credit:

- 18 hours of honors credit and
- 4 credit hours of senior project course work (HON 4000 and 4500).

Honors credit includes:

- Honors courses (HON seminars or discipline-specific -900 sections).
- Honors contract courses (maximum of 12 credit hours).

Honors Students will take at least one honors course per year until 18 hours of credit are complete, unless granted a waiver by the Dean.

Helpful Academic Notes:

- All honors courses have either an HON prefix or a -900+ section number, and they are listed on the Honors College website each term.
- Honors Contract Courses are upper-level courses that can count as honors courses via special agreement.
- Almost all honors courses fulfill General Education requirements. It is generally best to take them early and often, saving the senior project until closer to graduation.
- The Honors College staff is available to assist with all honors advisement questions.

Honors Perks and Points of Interest:

- The honors computer lab and reading room in Hickory Hall is available Monday–Friday 8-5.
- The Student Honors Council meets regularly to plan events and discuss honors issues. Officer information is on the Honors College website.
- Enrolled honors students have priority registration status.
