



Assistant or Associate Professor – Elementary Education

The University of North Carolina at Pembroke School of Education seeks qualified candidates for a tenure track faculty position in Elementary Education at the Assistant or Associate Professor rank, beginning August 15, 2008. The minimum qualifications include an earned doctorate in Elementary Education or Curriculum and Instruction from a regionally accredited institution; a minimum of three years K-6 teaching experience in a public school setting; and knowledge/experience or a willingness to use technology in delivering instruction. Applicants should hold (or be eligible for) North Carolina licensure in Elementary Education.
