



JOSEPH B OXENDINE DISTINGUISHED PROFESSORSHIP in EDUCATIONAL LEADERSHIP

The University of North Carolina at Pembroke School of Education seeks qualified candidates for a distinguished faculty position in Educational Leadership at the Professor rank, beginning August 15, 2008.

Responsibilities include teaching graduate courses in educational leadership, assisting the department chair in coordination and promotion of the Master of School Administration Program, conducting scholarly research, providing service to the University, the School of Education, and regional school partners.

The qualifications should include an earned doctorate in Educational Leadership, Educational Administration or a related area from a regionally accredited institution. Qualified candidates should also have considerable school based experience working with diverse populations; significant experience with master's level administration preparation programs; demonstrated potential for scholarly research, publication, and teaching; and knowledge/experience or a willingness to use technology in delivering instruction. Applicants should hold (or be eligible for) North Carolina licensure in administration.
