



Assistant or Associate Professor in Mass Communication

Department of Mass Communication at University of North Carolina at Pembroke seeks Assistant or Associate Professor of Mass Communication to teach generalist mass communication courses as well as courses that could include the following content (for both radio and TV where applicable): broadcast programming and management, broadcast journalism, commercial copywriting, multicamera directing for studio production, field videography, digital postproduction in a Macintosh environment, webcasting, production management. Position teaches four courses or sections per semester.

Successful candidates will be able to provide hands-on instruction in production courses, by demonstrating the technology, troubleshooting, and being available outside of class to assist in open labs, equipment checkout, and remote productions. College teaching experience and professional media experience required. Ph.D. in mass communication or related field required.

The Department offers a B.S. in mass communication, and students choose a required track in broadcasting, journalism, or public relations. The department offers minors in each of those and in “media integration,” an interdisciplinary minor with art and music faculty. Broadcasting activities of the department include operation of the county’s PEG access channel, original studio productions with local content, multicamera productions (such as live sports) on location, live internet streaming, and podcasting. Future possibility to move the broadcasting track to a new college of the arts.

Review of applications will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled.
