



Lecturer in Social Work

The Social Work Program at UNCP seeks one fulltime position to teach undergraduate social work courses beginning August 2008. Qualifications: An MSW with at least two years post Master's practice experience required. Ph.D. preferred. Commitment to teaching, research and scholarly activity expected. The candidate selected for this position will be a member of an academic department, commensurate with her/his scholarly preparation and academic credentials. Academically, this faculty position will report to the social work department chairperson for teaching and instruction. For the advisement/recruitment duties, this position will report to the Director of Distance Education through the Program/Site Coordinator at UNC Pembroke's Distance Education Site at Sandhills Community College.

The applicant selected for this faculty position will be required to teach 9 to 12 credit hours per years (Fall and Spring Semesters and Summer School) per 12-month calendar year within the appropriate academic department(s). The actual teaching of these 9 to 12 credit hours is in addition to academic advisement, the person in this position will be required to set up and supervise social work interns in their field placements.

General Job Requirements and Qualifications

The occupant of this position will:

- Work with the Site Coordinator to design and implement an approved enrollment growth and program enhancement plan.
- Teach Social Work Courses to include on-line courses.
- To secure field placements for social work students
- To oversee field placements in the Sandhills area.
- To advise social work students.
- Promote Distance Education, Outreach and Academic Affairs in the Sandhills community.

Academic Preparation And Qualifications

- ◆ A master's degree in Social Work from a CSWE accredited Social Work Program is required and will be considered, but a PhD is desired.
- ◆ Appropriate credential for a non-tenure track faculty appointment within the social work department.
