Job Description:

The Lecturer/Compliance Officer position will require the successful candidate to teach in the HPER Department and be able to perform all duties of a compliance officer. Minimum Education and Experience:

Master's degree required in health, physical education, recreation, exercise science, or closely related field. Must be able to teach any course in a HPER Dept. Prior collegiate teaching experience preferred. Successful candidate should possess or be able to pass after employment a CPR Certification Exam and NCAA Recruiting Exam.

Employment Type:

9-month term, full-time. Salary commensurate with qualifications and experience.
