COMPLETE this application for admission if you are:

1. A non-U.S. citizen outside of the United States.
2. A non-U.S. citizen studying in the United States as an F-1 Student.

DO NOT complete this application if you are:

1. A U.S. citizen within or outside of U.S. territory.
2. A Permanent Resident/"Green Card" Holder in the U.S. or in the process of obtaining permanent residence.

While substantively the same as the UNCP Undergraduate Admissions Application, this special Undergraduate Admissions Application for International Students is specially designed to make the application process easier for both individual students and The University of North Carolina at Pembroke Office of Admissions. This application excludes certain questions (e.g. North Carolina residency) that do not apply to international students and asks some additional questions (e.g. citizenship) that are important only to international students. This application also contains additional forms like the Financial Certification Form and the International Student Advisor's Report. You may choose to complete the Undergraduate Admissions Application rather than this Application for International Students. However, failure to present some information and forms may result in a delay in your application.

Transcripts

All transcripts submitted must be OFFICIAL, SEALED and/or CERTIFIED as official. All transcripts must be in English. In some nations Exit Exams (e.g. A-levels or O-levels) are accepted in lieu of transcripts. In some cases (especially for transfer students wishing to receive credit for previous college-level work completed at foreign institutions), international students may be required to obtain an external evaluation of their transcripts. TOEFL and/or SAT/ACT requirement

MOST international students are required to submit TOEFL results. Exceptions are made on an individual basis in which case the SAT and/or ACT is required. In cases where a student's country's primary language is English and the individual student's first language is English, the student is required to take the SAT and/or ACT.

Financial Support Documents

The United States Immigration and Naturalization Service require that ALL international students submit proof of adequate financial support equal to or greater than the cost of one academic year of study. International Students receiving academic and/or athletic scholarships from within and/or from without of The University of North Carolina at Pembroke must have proof of said moneys forwarded to the UNCP Office of Admissions. Forms to show your ability to afford the cost of attending UNCP must be completed.

North Carolina Residency

Non-immigrant (F-1) students DO NOT qualify for in-state tuition costs.

Health Forms and Housing Application

Health Forms and the Application for Student Housing are presented to all students following acceptance to The University of North Carolina at Pembroke. This application for admission does not reserve a residence hall room. If you are accepted to UNCP, you **must** complete and return the Health Forms and Housing Application prior to enrollment.
