Rashan Kennedy rushed for 129 yards and a pair of touchdowns and quarterback Matt Evans threw for 126 yards, but it was UNCP's defense that dominated on Saturday, September 8, to help the Braves

notch their first win since 1950.

UNCP won 26-20 over visiting Pride of Greensboro College in a hotly contested game on Lumbee Guaranty Bank Field. UNCP's defense registered four sacks, 12 tackles for loss and five interceptions to offset a shaky day from the special teams. They held the Pride to just 234 yards of total offense in front of a record 4,209 fans that made their way to Pembroke for the home opener.
