

Survey Results For the UNC Pembroke Baccalaureate Class of 2002

Number Surveyed: 490*

Number of Responses: 152

Overall Response Rate: 31%

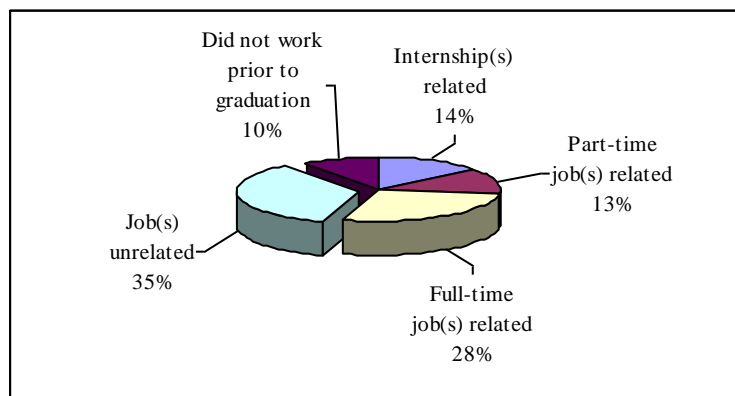
*Of the 490 possible respondents 351 were considered to be reachable via phone or mail.

Response Rate Among Reachable respondents was 43%.

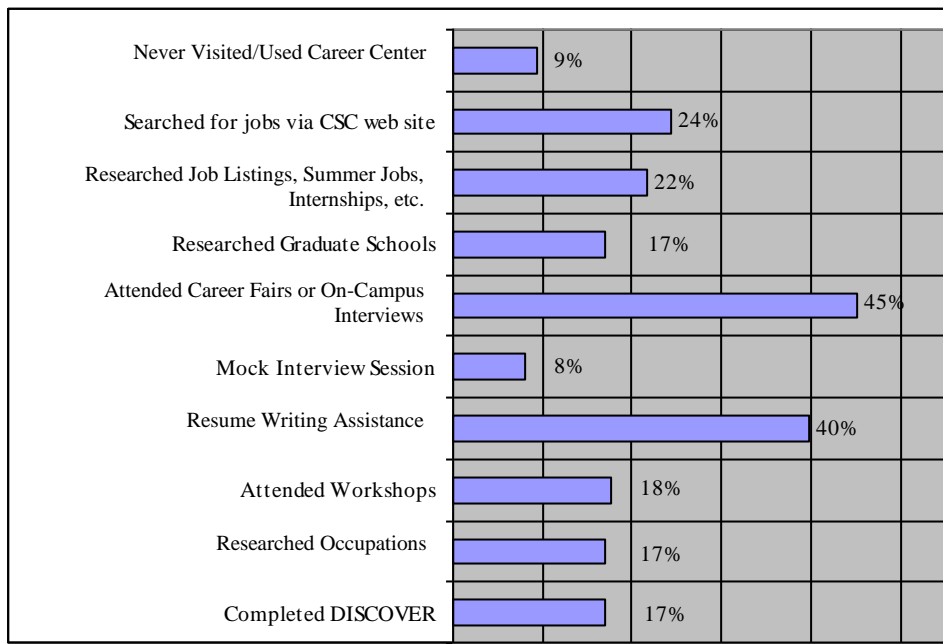
Summary of Results:

For the purposes of this survey, the class of 2002 is defined as graduates from August 2001, December 2001, and May 2002. These data reveal that, as of the summer of 2003, 85% of the baccalaureate graduates in the class of 2002 who responded to the survey were employed full-time, while 5% were unemployed and seeking employment. In addition, 20% were in school either part-time or full-time. 45% of respondents described their current employer as Education, while 16% indicated that they are employed in Business/Industry. When asked how they found their current jobs, 26% selected “direct contact” with their employer, while 21% indicated through family, friends, or faculty. The current salaries for the class of 2002 fall primarily in the \$20,001 – \$30,000 range (42%).

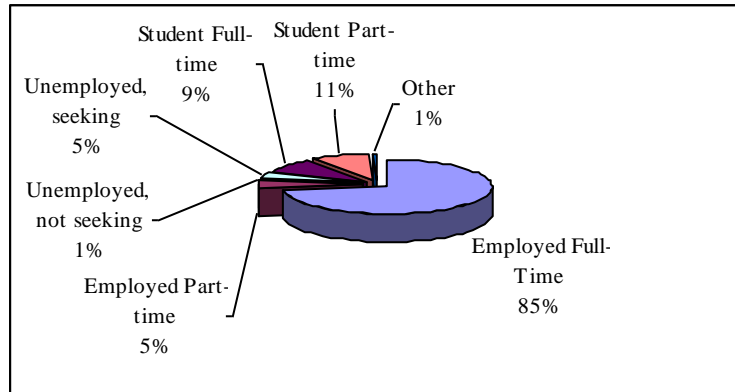

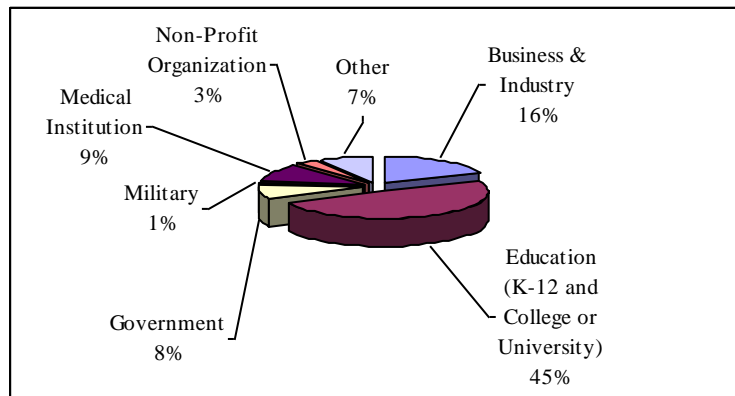
