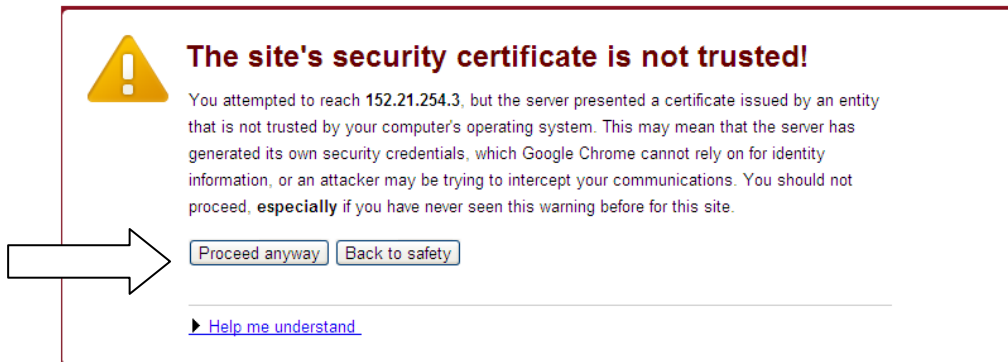


Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client Installation Guide Using Google Chrome


After starting Chrome, enter <https://152.21.254.3> in the address bar.

You will quite likely see the following:



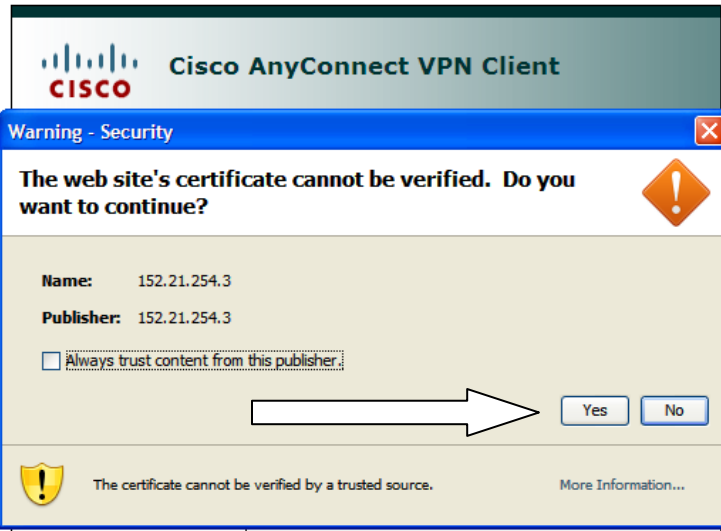
Please click on "Proceed anyway".

Next, enter your username and password. Insure that you have selected "UNCP_Staff" for "Group:".

You will then see the following:

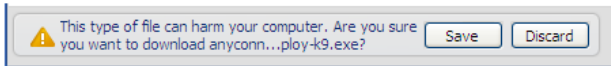


Click on the "Yes" button.

You will then see the following. Click the link to download the installer package.



You will be prompted at the bottom of your window with this:



Click save, and then double click on the downloaded file to begin the installation process. A window will pop up asking if you are sure you want to run this file, click yes.



Once you click run, a screen will appear for you to click next, then to agree to the License Agreement. Once you have done this, you will be able to continue with the installation.

It will run through an installation process, and when that is finished, click “finish”.



Once the Setup Wizard closes, you will see a window like this:
