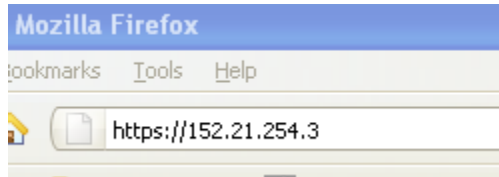


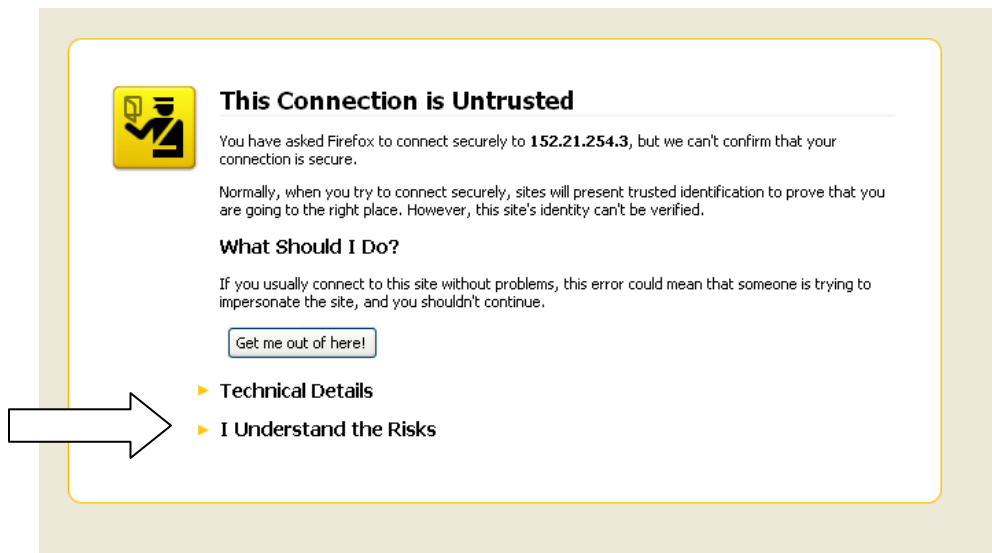
Cisco AnyConnect VPN Client Installation Guide

Using Mozilla Firefox 3.6

After starting Firefox, enter <https://152.21.254.3> in the address bar as shown:



You will quite likely see the following:

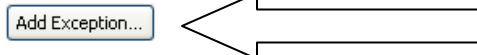


Please click on "I understand the Risks".

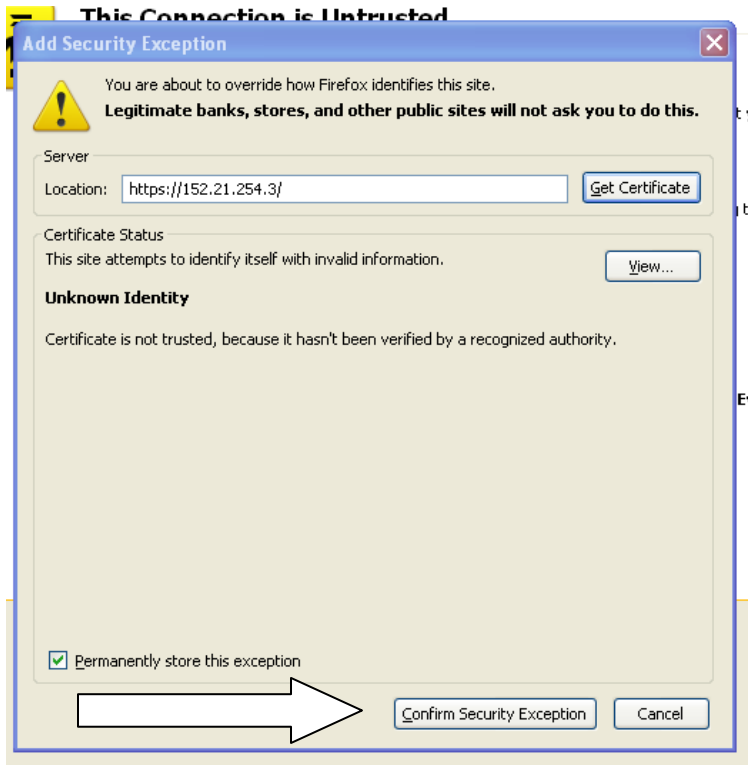
If you understand what's going on, you can tell Firefox to start trusting this site's identification. **Even if you trust the site, this error could mean that someone is tampering with your connection.**

Don't add an exception unless you know there's a good reason why this site doesn't use trusted identification.



Click the "Add Exception" button.

Next, click on the “Confirm Security Exception” button.



Next, enter your username and password. Insure that you have selected “UNCP_Staff” for “Group:”.

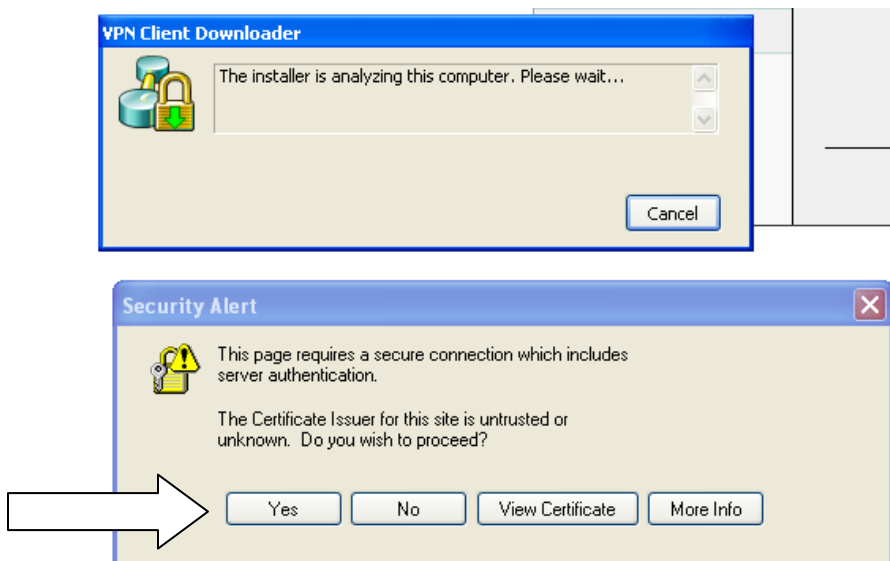
