These are paid positions that receive pay at the GS-04/Step 1 level of approximately \$13.59 per hour.

Student applicants must be US citizens with a 3.0 or higher GPA with at least 60 hours earned. They must be available to complete a one-year initial appointment agreement and be available to work 20 hours per week between 7:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m., Monday through Friday at Ft. Bragg. In addition, applicants must be eligible to obtain an interim secret security clearance and be in good standing with the University.
