Article Databases:

Academic Search Complete

Academic Search Complete is a multi-disciplinary full-text database with more than 5,500 full-text periodicals, including more than 4,600 peer-reviewed journals. In addition to full text, this database offers indexing and abstracts for more than 9,500 journals and a total of nearly 10,000 publications including monographs, reports, conference proceedings, etc. The database features PDF content going back as far as 1865.

ERIC

Indexing and abstracts of scholarly journals covering the social sciences, humanities, education and more from 1966.

North Carolina Standard Course of Study

Provides specific goals and objectives based on discipline and grade level.

PsycINFO

PsycINFO , from the American Psychological Association (APA), contains over 2 million citations and summaries of scholarly journal articles, book chapters, books, and dissertations, all in psychology and related disciplines, dating as far back as the 1800s. 98 percent of the covered material is peer-reviewed. Journal coverage, which spans 1887 to present, includes international material selected from more than 2,200 periodicals in more than 27 languages.
