*Congressional Universe* (via Lexis-Nexis)

Comprehensive access to U.S. legislative information including Congressional publications, laws, bill and regulations and member and committee information.

Government Periodicals Index (via Lexis-Nexis)

Index of approximately 250 magazines and newsletters from U.S. government agencies. Covers the arts, economics, justice and the sciences.

*PAIS (Public Affairs Information Service) International*

The PAIS International database contains references to more than 553,300 journal articles, books, government documents, statistical directories, grey literature, research reports, conference reports, publications of international agencies, microfiche, Internet material, and more.

*Policy File*

PolicyFile is an online service which indexes research and publication abstracts addressing the complete range of public policy research, covering all public policy issues from trade with Asia to health care reform, from terrorism to telecommunications regulation. It draws its content from public policy think tanks, university research programs, research organizations and publishers and includes famous well known organizations such as Brookings Institution, International Monetary Fund, United States Institute of Peace or World Bank, etc.

*Social Sciences Citation Index*

Consists of multidisciplinary indexes of bibliographic information gathered from thousands of scholarly journals.
