Using CAMIO

OCLC's **Catalog of Art Museum Images Online** is a growing online collection documenting works of art from around the world, representing the collections of prominent museums. **CAMIO** highlights the creative output of cultures around the world, from prehistoric to contemporary times, and covering the complete range of expressive forms.

Access: Go to the Library's homepage at www.uncp.edu/library/. Click **Electronic Resources**. Click **Database Title**. Click the letter **C** and you will see a list of databases. Click **CAMIO**.

Searching and Browsing: Users can effectively search **CAMIO** for images by using keywords in the search box or by browsing the collection. To browse, simply locate and click the **Browse** link in the upper-right corner of the **CAMIO** home page.

From the following page, you can choose to browse items by museum or by work type including architecture, paintings, and photographs.

To search using keywords, enter one or more terms into the search box from the home page. You may also perform an Advanced Search for more precision searching based on selected search fields including **Creator** and **Date**, or by specific museum. See image below for an example.

Results: After conducting a search in **CAMIO**, you will be presented with a list of results based on your search terms. The default view of image results is in thumbnails, but you can also view the images in a list. **List View** includes the identifying information of the image. In **Thumbnails** view, you can rearrange the order of results by clicking the **Date**, **Creator**, **Type**, or **Museum** links in the upper-right hand corner of the page. See image.

Viewing Images: To view an image, simply click on the title of the image or click the image itself. When the image opens, you will see a description of the work below the image, as well as a control panel above and to the left of the image. The control panel allows you to zoom in and out and pan the image in different directions. You may also select a portion of the image to view in a new window by selecting the icon on the far right of the panel that reads **Clip Image in New Window**.

By clicking **View a high-resolution image** above the image, the image will open in a new window in the highest resolution. You may then download the image to a save drive. On a **PC**, right-click the image, and on a **Macintosh** hold control while clicking the image, then select **Save Picture as** or **Save Image as**.

Creating Favorites: It is possible to save sets of images in **CAMIO** called **Favorites**. While viewing an image, simply click the link **Add to Favorites** and the image will be temporarily saved. Click **View Favorites** to see saved images. From this page, you may view your favorites as a slide show or save them as a webpage for later viewing and presentation. You can also compare two images side-by-side. See image.
