CHECKOUT INFORMATION

University students, faculty, and staff need to present a BravesOne Card to check out library materials. No limit exists on the borrowing of general circulating books. However, media (videos, DVDs, etc.) are limited to a specific number of items. Community borrowers must join the Friends of the Library to obtain a library card and are limited to **5** total items. Only **1** bestseller or McNaughton book may be borrowed by any borrower at a time. Wireless laptops and portable DVD players can be checked out for library use only by UNCP Faculty, staff, and students for **3** hours. MP3 players can be checked out for **3** weeks.

Borrowing Periods

- General/Folio/Juvenile Circulating Collection – 3 weeks (may be renewed if there are no holds or fines of \$25 or more).
- Bestsellers/McNaughton books – 1 week (may be renewed for 1 week if there are no holds or fines of \$25 or more).
- Media – 1 week.
- Wireless Laptops/Portable DVD players – 3 hours.
- Reserve Items – determined by instructor
- All items are due at the end of the semester
- MP3 players – 3 weeks.

Returning Items

Library materials may be deposited at the Circulation Desk, the book drop accessible at the front of the Library, or in the book drop at the information kiosk on Faculty Row.

Fines/Fees/Lost Items

Fines are charged for some overdue items. Fines for reserve materials are \$1.00 per loan period, with a \$10 maximum. Fines for equipment are \$10 per loan period. A \$15 processing fee will be charged for any lost or severely overdue item, in addition to the replacement cost of the item. Check with the Circulation Desk for fines regarding reserve items and wireless laptops.

ELECTRONIC RESOURCES (DATABASES)

The Mary Livermore Library provides access to over 250 web-based electronic databases. The web-based databases are accessible from any networked campus computer and via remote access through the Library's Electronic Resources page www.uncp.edu/library/electronic/. Online Catalog

BraveCat is the Library's online catalog for finding materials available in the Library. Materials can be searched for by author, title, subject, or keywords. *BraveCat* can be used to search the collections of UNC Pembroke, UNC Wilmington, and Fayetteville State University libraries.

OTHER SERVICES AND EQUIPMENT

Study Rooms

Study rooms and carrels are available on the Library's second floor and may be used on a first come, first served basis. Rooms 240H and 240E are reserved for group use. Groups may check out a key for access to these rooms from the Circulation Desk.

Assistance for Persons with Disabilities

Library users requiring assistance in accessing library materials may ask any library staff member for help. Specially designated workstations are available for persons in wheelchairs.

Interlibrary Loan/Document Delivery

Interlibrary Loan/Document Delivery is a service for library users who need to request materials. The Mary Livermore Library charges no fee for interlibrary borrowing, although fees may occasionally be charged by the lending library which will be passed on to undergraduate students. Requests must be made online from the Library's home page at www.uncp.edu/library/. Once there, click **Request Materials** to create an ILLiad account. For assistance, contact 910.521.6656. **Please allow a reasonable time frame for materials to arrive as delivery times vary.**

Wireless Laptops

The Library provides wireless laptops for use by UNCP students, faculty, and staff. Laptops may be borrowed from the Circulation Desk for 3 hours and must not leave the Library. The laptops are connected to the campus wireless network and may be used for accessing the Internet and word processing. In order to check out a laptop, a loan agreement must be signed. The overdue fee for laptops and accompanying accessories is \$10 per hour.
