

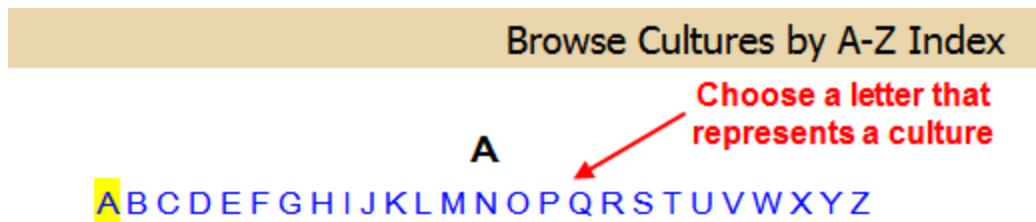

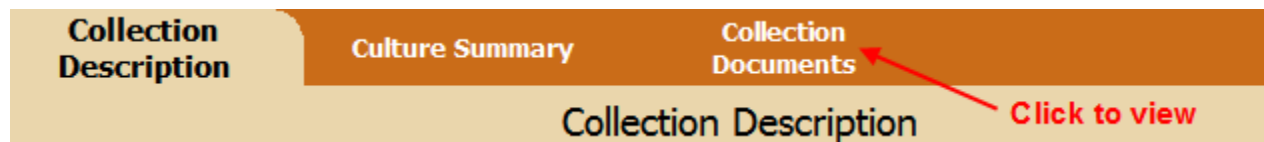
Using eHRAF World Cultures

Access: Go to the Library's homepage at www.uncp.edu/library/. Click **Electronic Resources**. Click **Database Title**. Click the letter **E** and you will see a list of databases. Click **eHRAF World Cultures**.

Browse: Click **Browse** from the homepage if you have a specific culture in mind that you would like to find information on. Simply use the **A-Z index** shown below if you want to find a culture. You can also browse by **Region** or **Country**.



Once you have located the culture you are looking for, click on it. Next, you will see a description of the culture. To view documents from books and articles on the culture, click **Collection Documents**.



After clicking on a document you are interested in viewing, you will see a description of the article or book including an abstract. To browse through the document, you can choose a section from the **Table of Contents** on the left-hand side of the page, or you can select individual pages you would like to look at. Use the navigation bar below to select specific pages.



Search: Use the **Search** link for a more focused search. To combine a culture with subject terms, click **Advanced**. The Advanced Search allows you to enter multiple cultures with subjects and text.

Click to run search →

Use the **Add/Remove** buttons to enter a culture or subject. When you do so, a small box will open in a new window. Use the + and – signs to narrow and expand the list. To combine the fields, select the **AND** button.

You may also add additional terms by typing them in the text box. Click **Submit eHRAF Search** when you are satisfied with your strategy.

Printing and Email Records: Users may print and email desired documents. When reading a document, simply check the box next to the paragraph(s) you want. Then click either of the silver buttons to print or email. Check multiple paragraphs to print or send all at once.

 Therefore, to isolate economic, political and religious processes and to analyse their interdependence, it is necessary to study their concomitant variations in the course of events in historical time.
