### Electronic Databases:

#### *Academic Search Premier*

A multi-disciplinary database providing indexing for over 8,000 publications, with full text for nearly 4,500 of those titles. PDF back files to 1975 or further are available for well over one hundred journals, and searchable cited references are provided for more than 1,000 titles.

#### *Criminal Justice Abstracts*

Citations to major journals in criminology and related disciplines.

#### *National Criminal Justice Reference Service (NCJRS) Abstracts*

The *National Criminal Justice Reference Service Abstracts Database* contains summaries of more than 170,000 criminal justice publications.

#### *National Criminal Justice Reference Service (NCJRS) Virtual Library*

Searches the NCJRS web site and the web sites of the agencies of the U.S. Department of Justice, Office of Justice Programs, and the White House Office of National Drug Control Policy, and the NCJRS collection of 7,000+ full-text publications.

#### *Social Services Abstracts*

*Social Services Abstracts* provides bibliographic coverage of current research focused on social work, human services, and related areas, including social welfare, social policy, and community development. The database abstracts and indexes over 1,406 serials publications and includes abstracts of journal articles and dissertations, and citations to book reviews.
