Click on **BraveCat (Catalog)**.

Click on **Journal Finder** to find out if the Library provides an electronic full text version of journal articles or provides the journal title in print.

Click on **Electronic Resources**, click on **Database Title**, and then, under "Quick Links" on the right, click on **EbscoHost**. From **EBSCOHost**, check the boxes for **MasterFILE Premier** and **Academic Search Premier** (optionally, check the boxes for **MLA International Bibliography**, **ATLA Religion Database with ATLASerials**, and/or **Communication & Mass Media Complete**), and then click on **Enter**.

Click on **Electronic Resources**, click on **Database Title**, and then under "Quick Links" on the right click on **OmniFile**.

Click on **Electronic Resources**, click on **Database Title**, and then click on **Encyclopedia Britannica Online**.

Click on **Electronic Resources**, click on **Database Title**, and then click on **Oxford Reference Online: Premium Collection**. Either choose a subject such as **Mythology & Folklore** or search.

Click on **Electronic Resources**, click on **Database Title**, and then click on **WorldCat** to find materials owned by other libraries that may be borrowed through Interlibrary Loan.

Click on **Reference Services**, click on **Resource collections and search engines**, and then click on **Librarians' Index to the Internet**. Use **Search** to find links to reputable Web sites.

Click on **Electronic Resources**, click on **Database Subject**, and then choose the appropriate subject to find additional online resources.
