Electronic Databases:

Academic Search Complete

A comprehensive scholarly, multi-disciplinary full-text database, with more than 5,400 full-text periodicals, including more than 4,500 peer-reviewed journals

Congressional Universe

A database which provides comprehensive access to U.S. legislative information including Congressional publications, laws, bill and regulations and member and committee information.

Government Periodicals Index

Index of approximately 250 magazines and newsletters from U.S. government agencies. Areas covered include the arts, economics, and justice.

Thomas

Thomas is a database which provides the full text of bills (103rd Congress and after), laws, Congressional Record (103rd and after), most committee reports, and many of the Library of Congress's excellent guides to legislation.

Omnifile Full-Text

A multi-disciplinary database providing the complete content - indexing, abstracts, and full text - from six of Wilson's full-text databases.
