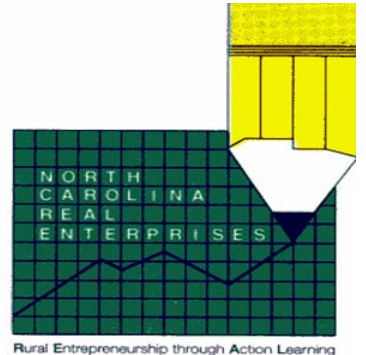

- must have parental permission to participate.



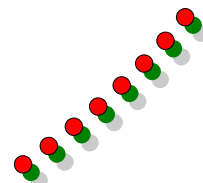
