Course Descriptions

Arts and Crafts

Clowning Around – Let Blinky and Bunky give you a complete clown makeover! After you choose the type of clown you want to be, select clown wear; design and apply make-up; develop your character and perform a clowning around skit. Learn the major rope trick and create a balloon sculpture.

NEW! Creative Paper Crafts – Use big imaginations and colorful papers to create dancing monsters, insects, jungle animals and other fun 3-D paper sculptures. Each day a new creation will be constructed to take home and share with family and friends.

NEW! You've Got the Look – Portraiture has long been an important subject matter in the arts. Using a variety of materials and processes, explore an interesting topic...you! Use a variety of materials/media to affect the expressive qualities of your portraits. Draw or paint portraits of your fellow campers and learn how observing live models can improve portraiture.

NEW! Cooking Wizardry – No baking required! Have you ever made play dough out of peanut butter? In this class you will create fun snacks, desserts, and drinks that will taste great and keep your kitchen cool all summer! You will also make a keepsake cookbook to share your recipes at home. Be sure to bring your appetites!

Jewelry Galore – Jewelry – you can never have enough. Try your hand at several different projects using glass beads, plastic beads, wood beads, wire, Sculpey clay, buttons, and other decorative findings. Make bracelets, necklaces, earrings ankle bracelets, room decorations, and much more. Fill your jewelry box with beautiful things!

NEW! Summer Memories – Do you want to capture all your great summer memories? Bring your memories and photos and create a scrapbook to look at for years to come.

NEW! Awesome Art – Come explore different kinds of projects and media. Activities include: paper-mache, rock critters, stories and illustrations with finger-paint art, clay sculpture, and t-shirt painting. Parents are asked to provide a pre-washed, light-colored t-shirt for their child to decorate. We will get messy!

Math & Games of Strategy

NEW! Hands-on Math – Think math is all paper-and-pencil activities? Think again! In this class we explore concepts such as measurement, estimating, graphing, and adding and subtracting, using M&M's, dice, pasta nobles, straw clips, leaves, and flowers. Who thought learning math could be so much fun?

NEW! Teens and Money – This class will focus on the concept of money. Even at a young age it's important for teen to know basic skills and spending and saving money. NEW! Card Sharks – Playing cards are inexpensive, portable and a great way to reconnect with family. Learn to play several games like Euchre, Pitch, Solitaire and more. Hours of fun with friends.

Science

NEW! Wacky Water Watchers – Are you THIRSTY for knowledge!? Come “WET” your brain in the wild world of water! Things that swim, things that grow, and things that glow! Take a water safari through history. Travel the world in search of water without leaving your seat.

NEW! Homemade Musical Instruments – Making homemade musical instruments can be fun! In this class students will complete simple science experiments to understand how musical instruments make sound. They will read stories why musical instruments were invented and how they were first used. Students will then make their own musical instruments using both recycled and new materials. Join us as we make music together!

Oooo, Goo and Stinky Too! Gross Science – Come and explore the weird and wacky world of science. If you're daring, cover five areas of science, one each day. Use your senses of sight, touch, and smell for these experiments. Chemistry concoctions, yucky biology, wacky physics, and wild ecology will capture your scientific curiosity. Enjoy science as you never have before!

Pets and Vets – Caring for pets, making a bird feeder, learning about endangered species, and discovering the duties of a vet are some of the educational, creative, and fun activities in this unique class. Learn animal behavior facts, tricks, and tips on grooming, feeding, and becoming a responsible pet owner. Develop sensitivity and skills so that you may make a difference in protecting animals and pursuing a possible career.

NEW! Rainforest Fun – Rainforests are home to two-thirds of the Earth's plant and animal species and are the world's largest pharmacies because of the many natural medicines they produce. Discover the many treasures lurking above, at, and below the rainforest canopy.

Under the Sea - Some of your favorite characters live in the ocean, Sponge Bob and Patrick, the Little Mermaid, and Nemo to name a few. Discover how creatures from sponges to starfish to sharks survive under water. You'll learn about many life forms and how they differ from things that live on land. On Thursday you will visit the Ocean Life Center to get a close-up look at some of the plants and animals that live in the ocean.

Your Insides Out—This is an introduction to human anatomy that is all about fun. Learn about the human body and how it works. Discover the functions of the organs in your body. Find out how your bones are connected, what your kin does for you and test your five senses through a series of fun games, activities and experiments.

NEW! Crime Scene Investigators—Do you love the hit TV drama, CSI and CSI: Miami? Well, you are going to love CSI: Pembroke. It is based off the hit TV show with a Pembroke spin. We will be conducting fingerprinting, paper chromatography, handwriting analysis, and much more. You will be detectives, just like the real guys and gals on TV. Using collected data as evidence and crime scene clues, you will solve a high profile case.

Social Studies

Fifty Nifty United States - Join this adventure through the 50 United States of America. Explore state capitals, silly laws, fun facts, state mottos, birds, flags, and exciting histories. You will get into the geography of the USA as you taste many of the specialties of different regions.

North Carolina Heritage – Without leaving the classroom, we will travel through history through stories, crafts and other activities to learn about N.C.
