# UNCP Marshal Information

Students who are selected as UNC Pembroke marshals have the honor of serving the University and the University-wide community as official representatives of UNCP at official functions that are held on campus. One semester hour of credit may be earned for one year of service as a marshal. The responsibilities of the marshals will be:

1. To be available to serve from Commencement 2005 through Commencement 2006.
2. To serve as usher at many University functions, including:
  - A. May 2005 and 2006 graduation exercises, fall convocation (required of all marshals).
  - B. Student theatrical performances.
  - C. Season events (usually in evenings).
  - D. Other events as scheduled (e.g., Miss UNCP Pageant).

All marshals should expect to serve as usher *no fewer than* 10 times during the year.

Dress code for marshals:

1. Marshals provide their own attire.
2. Men: dark suits.
3. Women: white or black dress or white or black blouse and dark pants.

To be eligible to become a marshal, an applicant must:

1. Have a minimum 2.7 Grade Point Average (GPA).
2. Have completed a minimum of 12 hours course work at UNCP.
