1. The meeting was called to order at 3:30 pm
2. The 5 Feb 2004 minutes were approved
3. The agenda was approved.
4. The following proposals from the English, Theatre, and Language Dept. were unanimously approved:
 - 4.1 Delete SPE 315 Advanced Voice and Diction
 - 4.2 Add new 3 hr course ENG 325 Language in Society
 - 4.3 Modify the Speech Minor by replacing deleted SPE 315 (see above) with new ENG 325 (see above)
 - 4.4 Change current THE 165 Stage Costumes from a 1-hr course to 3-hrs
5. The following proposals from Mass Communications Dept. were unanimously approved:

Make the following revisions to the Journalism track:

 - 5.1 Change the numbering sequence of JRN 191, 192, 291, 292, 391, 392, 491, 492 to JRN 161, 162, 261, 262, 361, 362, 461, 462
 - 5.2 Add new required 3-hr course JRN 260 News Writing/Reporting;
 - 5.3 Add new required 3-hr course JRN 460 Investigative Journalism;
 - 5.4 Delete current PRE 214 Photography for Public Relations and replace it with new 3-hr JRN 320 Photojournalism and cross list it with PRE 320;
 - 5.5 Add new 3-hr course JRN 405 Magazine Writing & Editing as an elective
 - 5.6 Add new 3-hr course JRN 410 Online Journalism as an elective;
 - 5.7 Add new 3-hr course JRN 420 Science Journalism as an elective;
 - 5.8 Change course number of current JRN 400 Sports Journalism to JRN 325

Net result: total degree hrs of 120 will not change, but free electives will lose 3 hrs.

Make the following changes in the Public Relations track:

- 5.9 Crosslist new 3-hr course JRN 260 News Writing (see 5.2 above) as PRE 260 and require it in the Public Relations program;
- 5.10 Delete PRE 214 Photography for Public Relations and replace it with new PRE 320 Photojournalism and crosslist it with JRN 320 (see above);
- 5.11 Add new required 3-hr capstone course PRE 460 Public Relations Campaigns;
- 5.12 Add two new 3-hr program electives:
 - PRE 415 Advertising Media
 - PRE 420 Crisis Communication
- 5.13 Delete program requirement of BRD 316/160 Television Production in the PRE degree track;

Minor Changes:

- 5.14 Change course number of PRE 209 to 220;
- 5.15 Change course number of PRE 324 to 270;
- 5.16 Change course title of PRE 324 from Print Advertising to Introduction to Advertising
- 5.17 Note new cross list of JRN 260 with PRE 260;
- 5.18 Change course title of PRE 409 from Advanced Public Relations to Public Relations Case Studies;

Net Result: total degree hours remain the same

6. The following proposals from Sociology Dept. (Social Work Program) were approved unanimously:

On the “Intro” page for the BSW degree program (p. 187), make the following three program modifications:

- 6.1 Increase the required QPA from 2.0 to 2.23 and complete 75% (up from 50%) of the general education requirements;
- 6.2 Drop SOC 303 from the “Social Work Electives Section” down into the “University-wide Electives Section”;
- 6.3 Cap the number of hours that students can take during their student internship to 15;

Minor changes:

- 6.4 Change title of SWK 348 from Social Welfare & Policies I to Social Welfare & Policies;
- 6.5 Change title of SWK 448 from Social Welfare & Policies II to Social & Economic Justice;
 - Rationale: better reflects course content
- 6.6 For SWK 348, make ECN 100 or GGY 246 of equivalent a prerequisite or co-requisite

7. The following proposals from the Biology Dept. were approved unanimously:
 - 7.1 Change prerequisite of BIO 472 Prin of Genetic from CHM 100 to 131 because CHM 100 is no longer offered;
 - 7.2 Under prereq for BIO 371, clarify the wording to say: “PREREQ: BIO 100, CHM 130, 131, Recommended: CHM 250, 251.”
 - 7.3 Under prereq for BIO 461, clarify the wording to say: “PRERQ: BIO 100, 102; Recommended, CHM 250, 251, 371.”

8. The following proposals from the Art Dept were approved unanimously:
 - 8.1 Reduce the current Art Academic Concentration from its current 27 hours down to 18 hrs and delete ART 400 as an elective choice and replace it with ART 230; (i.e., Required 12 hrs: ART 101, 102, 132,& 205; Electives 6 hrs: choose two of the following: ART 105, 109, 111, 133, 140, 230, or 306) (Note: has been approved by Teacher Educ Committee);

Minor Course Title Changes to parallel wording of other studio courses:

 - 8.2 ART 202 from Intro to Digital Arts to Digital Arts Appreciation
 - 8.3 ART 300 from Digital Arts II to Advanced Digital Arts I
 - 8.4 ART 330 from Digital Arts III to Advanced Digital Arts II
 - 8.5 ART 430 from Digital Arts IV to Advanced Digital Arts III

Minor Prerequisite modifications for easier student scheduling:

 - 8.6 ART 230-change prereq from ART 101 & 132 to “ART 101 & 132” (for majors), or 202 (for non-majors);
 - 8.7 ART 250-change prereq from ART 101 to “ART 101 (for majors), or 202 (for non-majors)”;
 - 8.8 ART 251-change prereq from ART 250 to “ART 250 (for majors), or 202 (for non-majors)”;
 - 8.9 ART 256-change prereq from ART 200 or 230 to “ART 230 (for majors), or 202 (for non-majors)”

9. Proposals from the School of Education (Note: all proposals have been approved by the Teacher Educ Committee and the Graduate Council);

Biology & Science Education Undergraduate Program:

- 9.1 Remove EDN 448 Internship (6 hrs) and replace it with new 9-hr course SCE 449 Internship in Science in Secondary Schools; the 3 additional hrs will be taken from the elective section;
- 9.2 Change the Physics Concentration as follows:
- 9.21 Change current requirement of college physics (PHY 150, 151, 206, 207) to include the option of university physics (PHY 200, 101, 206, 207)
- 9.22 Remove PHY 448 and replace with PHY 400;

Biology & Science Education Program:

- 9.3 Add a new 36-hour non-licensure concentration in Biology to be added to the existing M.A. in Science Education (Note: has been approved by Graduate Council):
- A. Required SCE courses (choose two of following): 560, 561, 563/573;
- B. Required BIO courses; choose any 18 hrs from:
BIO 510, 512, 515, 520, 525, 535, 514-534
- C. Guided Electives 9-12 hrs
- D. Approved Capstone Experience

Birth-Kindergarten Education program:

- 9.4 Add new 3-hr course ECE 450 Practicum for Professionals in Pre-Kindergarten Settings
- Minor Changes:
- 9.5 Change course number of ECE 302 Practicum in Child Study B-5 to 390;
- 9.6 Change course title of ECE 301 from Child Study: Typical & Atypical Development, Birth-Five Years to “Introduction to Early Childhood Education Programs and Practices”

Elementary Education Program:

- 9.7 Change course title EDN 465 from Foundations, Educational Trends, and Practice in Pre-School Education to “Equitable Assessment in Democratic Classrooms”

K-12 Licensure Internship:

9.8 In the course description of EDN 449 Full-Semester Internship, add two words in the second sentence; i.e., “Includes placement at one or two levels....for K-12 licensure areas.”

10. The following proposals from the Music Dept. were approved unanimously:

10.1 Give MUS 298 History of Musical Theatre General Educ status, both as a Humanities/Fine Arts choice on p. 24 and also as a Humanities/Fine Arts Elective on p. 26 (Note: has been approved by Gen Educ Subcommittee)

10.2 Add new 1-hr courses THE 181 & 182 Stage Dance I & II as options to the Physical Education & Wellness Gen Educ activities courses list on p. 26 and crosslist them as PED/THE 181 and PED/THE 182 (Note: has been approved by Gen Educ Subcommittee)

10.3 Add new 3-hr course MUS 106 Basic Musicianship as a remediation course if the student doesn't pass the Music Theory Placement Test; (Note: this course does not count towards graduation requirements):

10.4 Add prereq to MUS 114 of “...student must successfully pass a placement test for enrollment...” to correspond to the new MUS 106 situation above

10.5 For current course MUS 243 Musical Theatre Styles I, add a prereq of “MUSP 151”

10.6 Brass, MUS 227 Class Strings, and MUS 228 Class Percussion from 1-hr each to “.5 hrs Change the course credit hours for MUS 225 Class Woodwinds, MUS 226 Class each” (*SEE NOTE BELOW)

Rationale: have to make 2-hrs of room in the Music Educ program and this was the only way to do it and still meet NC state DPI requirements

*NOTE TO ALL ACADEMIC COMMITTEES CONCERNING 10.6 ABOVE: THE UNCP REGISTRAR'S OFFICE WILL NEVER USE “.5” AS A GRADUATION FIGURE; (e.g., students wants to graduate with 119.5 hrs)

10.7 Add new eight-course sequence of MUS 116-117, 216-217, 316-317, 416-417 Orchestra (1 hr each) that will become the “major ensemble” requirement for bowed string instrument majors;

10.8 Decrease the Music Concentration requirement from 24 hrs down to 18 hours to bring it in line with other teacher education concentrations

11. The following minor proposals from the Honors College were approved unanimously (Note: have been approved by Gen Educ Subcommittee):
 - 11.1 Change the title of HON 200 from The Humanistic Tradition I to “The Humanistic Tradition I: Pre-History to the Baroque Era”
 - 11.2 Change title of HON 201 from The Humanistic Tradition II to “The Humanistic Tradition II: From Baroque to the Present”

14. Dr. Thompson announced that the next meeting would be 1 April 2004, and that it was not an “April Fool’s” joke
