4. **The following proposals from the Art Department were approved unanimously**
  - 4.1 **Modify the 3 credit-hour required course, ART 308 Art Education Field Experience for the BA in Art Education by requiring Admission to the Teacher Education Program as a new Prerequisite. Current Prerequisites—Art 305 & 306.**
  - 4.2 **Modify the BA in Art Education (K-12) Program by allowing majors to select either ART 102 Three Dimensional Design or ART 105 Introduction to Sculpture as a required course. Currently, only ART 105 is permitted. No change in total hours.**
5. **The following proposal from Computer Science Department was approved unanimously**
  - 5.1 **Create a new 3 credit-hour elective course CSCS 4XX Special Topics (Variable Title) Prerequisite—Permission of the Instructor.**
6. **The following Nonsubstantive proposals from Department of Chemistry and Physics were approved.**
  - 6.1. **Add CHM 111 as a prerequisite to CHM 226 Elementary Inorganic Chemistry, approved unanimously.**
  - 6.2. **Change the grading on CHM 480 Internship in Chemistry to Pass/Fail. Approved 8-0-1.**
7. **The following Nonsubstantive proposal from Department of Chemistry and Physics was not approved.**
  - 7.1 **Change the grading on CHM 399 Research in Chemistry to Pass/Fail. Did not pass 3-4-2.**
8. **Old Business—Changes in the Curriculum Forms must be approved by the Faculty Senate.**
