# BRAVE PRIDE

- ***A Place of History and Tradition:*** founded in 1887 as the Croatan Normal School, an institution to train American Indian public school teachers.
- ***A Place of Diversity:*** largest percentage of minority students of any four-year institution in North Carolina excluding Historically Black Colleges and Universities.
- ***A Place of Personalized Learning:*** Teaching and learning are at the forefront of everything we do.
- ***First Americans' Teacher Education (FATE) Program:*** a four-year teacher training grant funded by the U.S. Department of Education that addresses the shortage of American Indian (AI) teachers in public school districts .
- ***ART Department earns NASAD accreditation:*** one of five North Carolina schools to earn accreditation from the National Association of Schools of Art and Design (NASAD).
- ***MSW program accreditation:*** earned from the National Council on Social Work Education.
- ***Nursing scores:*** highest among system schools
- ***A Military Friendly School:*** named by G.I. Jobs magazine for the fifth consecutive year.
- ***Community Service and Engagement:*** named to President Obama's Community Service Honor Roll for all three years of the award's existence.






