



The Integrated Postsecondary Education Data System

IPEDS is the core postsecondary education data collection program for the National Center for Education Statistics (U.S. Department of Education). Data are collected from all primary providers of postsecondary education in the country in areas including enrollments, program completions, graduation rates, faculty, staff, finances, institutional prices, and student financial aid. These data are made available on the IPEDS website to students, researchers and others.

Common Data Set

The CDS initiative is defined by its organizers as "a collaborative effort between publishers and the educational community to improve the quality and consistency of information reported by college and university officials and to reduce the burden of compiling such information which is used in guide books." That is, the common data set is used to pull into one place answers to commonly asked questions about the university. It includes information about enrollment/persistence, full-time first-time admissions, transfer admissions, academic offerings/policies, student life, annual expenses, financial aid, instructional faculty and class size, and degrees conferred.
