



Certificate of Financial Responsibility

United States Citizenship and Immigration Services (USCIS) requires that all F-1 or J-1 visa applicants provide evidence of sufficient funds available to pay for their educational, living and other expenses. Financial support can be a combination of personal and sponsored funding. Bank and/or sponsor letters must not be more than 6 months old.

Estimated cost of attendance includes **direct** (tuition/fees, room & board, health insurance) and **indirect** (books, supplies, miscellaneous and personal) expenses.
