

A.D. Gallery Rules and Regulations:

Entry

- Deposit backpacks, large bags, or umbrellas outside the main gallery, on the gallery steps, or in the back alcove of the gallery.
- Money and other valuables should be carried on your person.

Conduct in the gallery

- Food and drink may not be consumed in the galleries (with exception of receptions, when monitored by gallery staff).
- Smoking is not allowed anywhere in the galleries.
- Visitors have a right to quiet contemplation, study, or group discussion. Gallery staff will intervene where noisy or improper behavior disrupts the experience of other visitors.
- Potentially harmful substances (ex. aerosols, solvents, glues and dyes) and implements (ex. knives, scissors, exactos) must not be brought into the gallery.
- Please do not touch the works of art on display, unless they are designated “interactive”.
- Sketching of artwork on display is allowed using small drawing pads with pen or pencil. The use of charcoal, pastels, permanent markers, water or oil is not allowed in the galleries.
- Children are welcome in the gallery, but are to be accompanied and monitored by an adult at all times. Gallery staff will intervene where noisy or improper behavior disrupts the experience of other visitors.

Photography and filming

- Photography and filming are permitted on premises for personal use only.

Staff

A.D. Gallery staff has the right to work in a safe environment free from violence and threatening behavior. Campus police may be asked to escort a visitor out if acting in a violent or abusive way.
