## Clinical Lecturer

The Department of Social Work at the University of North Carolina invites applications for a full time, nine month Clinical Lecturer position. This is a non-tenure track position that may be renewed annually (based on the department's needs). Job responsibilities include teaching four courses per semester, assisting field directors in placing students in field agencies, providing supervision to students who are doing field placement, providing academic advisement to social work majors, helping in recruiting social work majors, serving on university and department committees, providing service to community, and undertaking other duties assigned by the department chair.

**Minimum Training and Experience Requirements:** A Master of Social Work degree from a CSWE accredited institution and two years or more of post MSW practice experience.

**Management Preference:** One year college teaching experience or two years' experience supervising social work interns in field agencies. Social work licensure.

**Special Instructions to Applicants:** Online applications should be submitted through UNC Pembroke Online Employment System. (<https://jobs.uncp.edu>) Applications should include the following:

1. Cover Letter
2. A current Curriculum Vitae
3. Names and contact information, including email addresses of, at least three reference.
4. Unofficial academic transcripts (scan copies and attach)

Applications will be reviewed until the position is filled

This position is subject to the successful completion of an employment background check. An employment background check includes a criminal background check, employment verification, reference checks, license verification (if applicable) and credit history check (if applicable).

If hired, the candidate will be required to submit proof of eligibility to work in the United States. New employees are paid only by direct deposit to the financial institution of their choice. Candidates claiming Veterans Preference must attach a copy of their DD-214 as a part of the online application process.
