The Department of Social Work at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke invites applications for a 9-month tenure-track faculty position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor. The Department of Social Work has both BSW and MSW degree programs. Specific programs include advanced standing, part-time and night/evening, and off-campus sites. Qualifications: A Master of Social Work degree from a CSWE accredited institution is required but preference will be given to candidates with: doctoral degree in social work or closely related field (ABD will be considered); a minimum of two years post MSW work experience; college/university teaching experience; ability/willingness to teach online courses, and ability/willingness to teach field seminar courses and supervise students in field placement. The successful candidate will teach across BSW and MSW social work curricula. He/she will provide academic advisement, develop curriculum/course syllabus, and/or online courses. In addition to instructional duties, he/she will be is required to participate in university and departmental committees and provide community services.

college/university teaching experience; ability/willingness to teach online courses; and willingness to teach across the BSW and MSW curricula.

This position is subject to the successful completion of an employment background check. An employment background check includes a criminal background check, employment verification, reference checks, license verification (if applicable) and credit history check (if applicable).
