## Assistant Professor of Art Education

**DESCRIPTION:** The Department of Art at The University of North Carolina at Pembroke is seeking applications for a full-time, tenure-track faculty position in Art Education to begin fall 2019. This position will serve as Director of Art Education Graduate Programs. We seek an applicant who will build relationships with K-12 educators throughout the region, help grow the Art Education graduate program, and provide leadership in curriculum development and credential preparation. The selected candidate will teach both graduate and undergraduate art education courses and should have a commitment to excellent teaching and college service, including participation in student advising, assessment, recruitment, and retention. The ideal candidate will also have teaching experience in studio art and general education courses including painting, drawing, art appreciation, or other studio art courses. The Assistant Professor will act as liaison with other appropriate sectors of the campus responsible for teacher education and with the PreK-12 community. Candidates must demonstrate ongoing commitment to professional memberships and research in art education.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Ph.D. or Ed.D. in Art Education; previous college teaching experience (including teaching assistantships); minimum of three years of successful art teaching experience in K-12 schools; credentials and experience teaching graduate and undergraduate-level art education courses and a range of studio art courses; a comprehensive knowledge of Art Education theory and pedagogy and the ability to apply related theory to practice; record of scholarly and/or creative work, such as publications, presentations at conferences, and exhibitions; excellent interpersonal skills, both in oral and written communication.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Academic responsibilities include teaching, research, and advising. This position carries a 3-4 [S1] teaching load with a possible reduction for administrative duties each academic year. The Assistant Professor will be responsible for teaching graduate and undergraduate courses in Art Education such as content and pedagogical courses, including elementary or secondary method courses. This position also requires supervising graduate level art education students in the field. Additional teaching responsibilities may include painting or drawing, art appreciation, or other studio art courses. The selected candidate will have additional responsibilities that include research, committee work, curriculum development, service to the university and community, and professional activities in art education. Additional responsibilities include monitoring program compliance with accreditation standards for the

graduate Art Education program for both CAEP (Council for the Accreditation of Educator Preparation) and NASAD (National Association of Schools of Art and Design).

Applicants must apply using the UNCP Online Employment System at <https://jobs.uncp.edu>. Attach a letter of interest, vita, copies of transcripts, list of 3 references, teaching philosophy, artist statement, 2 examples of scholarly work, and PowerPoint presentations of 8-10 examples of K-12 student artwork, 5-8 examples of college level student artwork (if applicable), 8-10 examples of personal artwork clearly labeled. Review of applications will begin December 1st and will continue until the position is filled.

The Art Department includes 10 tenured or tenure-track faculty, 1 Visiting Martha Beach Endowed Chair, 8 adjuncts, and 1 studio technician. The department is accredited by NCATE and NASAD. We offer a BA degree in Art with Art Education (K-12) Track, Art History Track, and Studio Art Track with specialization in Ceramics, Digital Arts, Drawing, Painting, Printmaking, and Sculpture; minors in Media Integration Studies, Studio Art, and Art History; as well as MA and MAT degrees in Art Education.
