## Assistant Professor Modern European History

The University of North Carolina at Pembroke invites applications for a tenure-track Assistant Professor position in modern European history (1789 to the present) with a specialty in the history of modern France. In addition to teaching specialized courses in his or her area of expertise, the successful candidate will offer advanced period courses (1789-1914 and 1914 to the present) in European history and will contribute to the General Education load in the department by offering introductory courses in World Civilizations (both prior to and since 1500). The successful candidate will also teach periodically an historical methods course. Of particular interest to us are candidates who take a transnational/imperial/global approach in both their teaching and research. Applicants must have completed the Ph.D. in history by August 2019.

Interested teacher-scholars should submit an online application, cover letter, curriculum vitae, and a list of references through the UNCP Online Employment System ([jobs.uncp.edu](http://jobs.uncp.edu)). The UNCP Department of History expects faculty to demonstrate a strong commitment to teaching and be actively engaged in professional scholarship and university service.
