The Department of Biology invites applications for an Assistant Professor of Biology: Ecology at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke. Broadly trained ecologist needed for teaching responsibilities of both lectures and labs among a variety of courses depending on candidate's background and qualifications, beginning Fall 2019 (9-month appointment). Minimum qualifications are PhD level degree in Ecology or an appropriate area of Biology. Faculty members are expected to be active in the publication and presentation of scholarly research as well as engaged in appropriate university and department service.

Applicants must apply via the UNC Pembroke Online Employment System at <http://jobs.uncp.edu/postings/4808> ; each applicant must submit: 1) a letter of interest, 2) updated Curriculum Vitae, and 3) names, addresses, and phone numbers of three references. Transcripts needed only upon request. Special consideration will be given to applications that are received by January 11, 2019.

This position is subject to the successful completion of an employment background check. An employment background check includes a criminal background check, employment verification, reference checks, license verification (if applicable) and credit history check (if applicable).

New employees are paid only by direct deposit to the financial institution of their choice.
