Applications are invited for an appointment as Senior Lecturer in the Department of Economics & Decision Sciences at the University of North Carolina at Pembroke to commence on August 1, 2019 or as soon as possible thereafter.

Minimum qualifications include a Master degree in Economics, strong experience in teaching Economics or Statistics or related courses, and a record of excellent teaching. Preferred candidates will have a PhD in Economics (or ABD), strong experience in teaching applied Economics or Statistics or related courses, and a record of scholarship and excellent teaching.

This position is subject to the successful completion of an employment background check. An employment background check includes a criminal background check, employment verification, reference checks, license verification (if applicable) and credit history check (if applicable).
