




WELCOME CLASS OF 2023

Welcome to The University of North Carolina at Pembroke!

Your first step toward becoming part of #BraveNation begins this summer with New Student Orientation (NSO). We encourage you to register for NSO today to secure your spot in the Class of 2023.

Upon your registration for New Student Orientation, you will get pre-registered for the courses most critical to your major. Students who register for orientation on or before May 1, 2019 will receive priority in pre-registration, regardless of your session date. Classes fill fast, so be sure you register as soon as possible!



REGISTERING FOR ORIENTATION

Registration will open on Wednesday, February 13, 2019. Our orientation sessions fill up quickly. Please sign up as soon as possible so that you can get the session you prefer.

GETTING STARTED

Please note: All reservations are made under the student's name and student ID Banner number. Before registering it is very important to check your dates! Many students register for orientation without considering important dates like graduation rehearsals and vacations.

All newly admitted students should pay their required non-refundable enrollment deposit as soon as they know UNCP is where they wish to attend. This deposit does several things for you: first, if you are living on campus, this serves as your housing application fee (you must still complete your application for student housing); second, it reserves your place in the class; and third, it covers the cost of your orientation fee. If you are a:

• FRESHMAN living on campus, you will pay \$300;

• FRESHMAN are required to live on campus. While living on campus is a requirement and privilege, request may be granted for an exception to the residency requirement. You can apply for an exception by completing the Freshman Housing Wavier Application (uncp.edu/housing). If approved, you will pay \$150.

Freshmen admitted for the summer/fall 2019 semester(s) should register for New Student Orientation by May 1, 2019. Students admitted after May 1, 2019, should register within two weeks of acceptance.

Web reservations are the most expedient way to make your reservation. Online reservations are processed immediately and you will receive an email confirmation at the time you make the reservation. If you have not yet paid your required non-refundable enrollment deposit, you can do so by visiting your Bridge2Brave portal. You can pay by using MasterCard or Visa. Once this fee is paid, you have declared your intent to attend UNC Pembroke. If you are unable to pay the enrollment deposit, there is an option to defer your payment to your fall tuition bill on the payment page in Bridge2Brave.

REGISTER ONLINE

- 1. Set up your BraveWeb account. For information on how to set up your BraveWeb account, please visit uncp.edu/account/start. To locate your secret code, please view your admissions acceptance letter in your Bridge2Brave portal.
- 2. Once you have your BraveWeb account open, please click on the Orientation Registration tab and log in to the account using your BraveWeb username and password (UNC Pembroke - Shibboleth Login). You will be directed to the Visual Zen Orientation Registration System.
- 3. Follow the instructions to select your orientation date. You may also pay the required non-refundable \$40 family fee for each family member who is interested in attending. The fee for family members and guest cannot be deferred and needs to be paid at the time of registration. Please make sure you consult with your family members when selecting a date. If a session is full, you will not be able to select it.
- 4. Please ensure you submit your registration.

Please note: An orientation date can be changed only once, and only if the session that you want to move into is open. To change your, date please email orientation@uncp.edu.

FAMILY/GUEST REGISTRATION

Reservations for family members require a \$40 non-refundable payment for each person. All registrations must be made by the student in their orientation registration portal. We are able to accept MasterCard or Visa at the time you make your reservation. After the initial reservation has been submitted, if you would like to add another guest to the reservation, you must submit your request by emailing orientation@uncp.edu. **Please note, we do not provide housing for family members.**

PREPARING FOR YOUR ORIENTATION EXPERIENCE

Student Rights and Responsibilities Overview (Student Code of Conduct)

All students are expected to conduct themselves in a responsible and accountable manner at all times. The Student Code of Conduct outlines prohibited conduct and assists students in understanding their rights and responsibilities while living and learning in the university community. The Student Code of Conduct can be located online at **uncp.edu/handbook**. Please review the Student Code of Conduct prior to attending your orientation session, as you will be held accountable for any violations.

Complete Mandatory Medical Information

Student Health Services requires three (3) steps for compliance with part of your University Requirements. **Step 1:** Health Form

- Step 2: Immunizations
- Step 3: Insurance Waiver or Enrollment

Step 1 and Step 2:

Please submit online your immunizations and health form prior to Orientation. All these documents must be completed online at our Student Health Patient Portal. The link is below https://uncp. medicatconnect.com.

North Carolina law requires all students enrolling in five (5) or more semester hours to submit a copy of their immunization records to their respective institutions.

Step 3:

Be Advised: Registered students taking six (6) or more credit hours are required to purchase the Student Health Insurance Plan. Waiver deadlines vary each semester. If you do not complete the waiver procedure, you will be enrolled in the student insurance and be required to pay the premium associated with the insurance policy.

Exceptions:

- Distance education students (students taking off campus and Internet only courses)
- Students who submit evidence of equivalent coverage satisfactory to the policyholder

Visit *uncp.edu/insurancewaiver* to waive out of the university sponsored plan.

Where will students stay during orientation?

The overnight stay is mandatory for all incoming first-year students. Students will be residing in Pine Residence Hall for all orientation sessions. Students will be provided a residence hall key and swipe card at check-in. Students are expected to be responsible for their key and adhere to all residence life policies. All students are required to return their key and swipe card at check-out on day two. Key replacement cost is \$40 and swipe card replacement cost is \$25. UNC Pembroke and/ or New Student Programs is not responsible for any items that are lost and/or stolen. **Family members will not be allowed to stay with their student in the residence hall during the overnight stay.**

Parking during Orientation

Parking on the day of orientation is free. Please park in student and open parking only. Please do not park in faculty/staff parking lots. Faculty/staff parking lots are monitored during orientation sessions and parking in one may result in a citation.

PREPARING FOR YOUR ORIENTATION EXPERIENCE

What should you bring to orientation?

- BraveNation spirit and energy
- Comfortable shoes and weather-appropriate clothing for two days
- Bedding and pillow (Linens are not provided. Bring sheets and blankets to accommodate a twin mattress.)
- Hygiene/toiletry products (make sure you include a towel, washcloth and any medication you might need)
 - Alarm clock
 - Umbrella
 - Pen and paper
 - Spending money
 - College and/or High School Transcripts (NOTE: If you attended an Early College, transcripts must come from both the High School and College.)
- A valid driver's license, non-driver's ID, military ID or passport, in order to obtain your Braves Card.

Students with Disabilities

Students who have a disability and are requesting accommodations while attending New Student Orientation should contact the Accessibility Resource Center (ARC) at 910.521.6695. Requests for accommodations should be made at least one week prior to the session date. However, a good faith effort will be made with notification less than one week to the session date.

College Credit

If you received college credit while in high school, please send an official transcript from the college prior to attending orientation. Please note that your high school transcript is not enough to grant college credit. Additionally, if you have taken any AP, CLEP or IB test, please submit your official test scores to Undergraduate Admissions for evaluation. Housing Requirement

The university embraces the on-campus residential philosophy by requiring first-year freshmen to reside on campus for their initial academic year. The university understands there are some extenuating situations that may prevent a freshman from residing on campus. For more information on the Housing Application or the Freshman Housing Waiver Application Form, please visit uncp.edu/housing. All students should pay their \$300 enrollment deposit prior to filling out the Housing Application. If you are applying for a housing waiver, you will be notified of your approval status. If approved, you will pay the \$150 enrollment deposit.

Financial Aid

To seek federal financial aid or UNC Pembroke scholarships, please submit your online Free Application for Federal Aid (FAFSA) at **fafsa.ed.gov**, and visit the Financial Aid website at **uncp.edu/fa** regarding scholarships. UNC Pembroke's Federal School Code is 002954. All students should complete the FAFSA prior to attending orientation. UNCP Email Account

Every UNC Pembroke student is assigned a BraveMail email account. All official communication (including billing and financial aid) is sent to the student's BraveMail account. It is important that you check this account regularly for important information. To access your email, go to uncp.edu and click on the MENU tab. The BRAVEMAIL (STUDENT) link will take you to the login page for your email account. Use your BraveWeb username and password to log in to BraveMail.

In-state Residency

If you are a new student and you have not yet applied for instate residency through the state-required Residency Determination Service electronic interview, www.ncresidency.org, please do so as soon as possible. This application will help to ensure that you receive the correct billing charges from the university. Upon completion, students will receive a Residency Certification Number (RCN). This unique identifier will allow all UNC System campuses to access your residency status. Please contact the Office of Undergraduate Admissions at 910.521.6262 with any questions.

Once your residency application has been reviewed, you will receive an email (and text if you opt-in) from the Residency Determination Service (RDS) regarding the determination (in state or out-of-state) or the status, i.e., need more information from you. If you receive an out-of-state determination and you do not agree with it, you may request a reconsideration of your residency decision from RDS up to three times within a 90-day period. For more information, call toll-free 844.319.3640.

It is the student's responsibility to have the above completed by or before the tenth day of class for a fall/spring start or the third day of class for a summer term (excluding MayMester) start for an in-state determination, if applicable, to be effective in the current term.
