Assistant Professor of Environmental Geology

The University of North Carolina at Pembroke seeks applications for an Assistant Professor of Environmental Geology in the Department of Geography and Geology. Faculty position is in environmental geology with expertise in hydrogeology. The incumbent will teach Environmental Geology and other courses in the department for our major in Geo-Environmental Studies and cognate programs (such as science education). The incumbent will additionally teach general education sections. The total course load will match the standard for tenure-eligible faculty. The incumbent will supervise the department's contract with the Robeson County Water Department for groundwater monitoring and engage in appropriate scholarship. This includes involvement of undergraduates in research. University and department service is also expected. The Ph.D. is required at the time of appointment. Applicants should be strongly committed to excellence in teaching and advising undergraduates, and to working in a multicultural environment that fosters diversity.
