Other responsibilities include, but are not limited to, program assessment and service to the department and university as needed.

Earned doctorate degree or ABD by January 2020 in exercise physiology, kinesiology, or a related field. A record of teaching, scholarship, and service at the collegiate level

ACSM or NSCA (or similar organization) certifications above the level of personal trainer/group fitness instructor.
