## Assistant Professor of Sociology

The Department of Sociology and Criminal Justice invites applications for one tenure track Assistant Professor of Sociology position for Fall 2020.

Successful applicant will teach introductory level, intermediate, advanced and writing intensive courses in sociology. Opportunities may be available to teach graduate courses in sociology. This position may require teaching and advising assignments at off-campus satellite programs. Serve as faculty adviser to students. Perform administrative tasks as directed by the department chair. Engage in scholarship including, but not limited to professional publications, conference presentations, and grant acquisition.

At the time of appointment, the successful candidate must have a Ph.D. in sociology. A juris doctorate and/or a doctorate in education will not be considered. All awarded degrees must be from regionally accredited colleges or universities.

Preference will be given to candidates with specialization, expertise, and interest in Community, Community Development, Non-Profit Organizations, and the intersections of Class, Gender, and Race.

Applicants are requested to provide a cover letter and CV outlining required education requirements, work experience, and contact information for 3 references. Do not send reference letters or official transcripts until requested to do so. Application review will begin immediately and continue until the position is filled.

This position is subject to the successful completion of an employment background check. An employment background check includes a criminal background check, employment verification, reference checks, license verification (if applicable) and credit history check (if applicable).

In compliance with federal law, all persons hired will be required to verify identity and eligibility to work in the United States and to complete the required employment eligibility verification form upon hire.

New employees are paid only by direct deposit to the financial institution of their choice. Candidates claiming Veterans Preference must attach a copy of their DD-214 as a part of the online application process.
