Description of Program: This will be a joint presentation between OGE and faculty that have led study abroad group travel at UNCP. OGE will present for 20-30 minutes on how to create a Faculty-Led Study Abroad by giving an overview and going over some basic logistics for relevant examples. Three faculty then will give presentations, about five minutes each, on what they have done to organize a study abroad.

Style of Presentation: PowerPoint and other visual aids will be used, but the style will be open for discussion at any point. Sharing of ideas is encouraged.

Target Audience: Faculty who are interested in leading their own study abroad and for knowledgeable faculty to share their experiences on study abroad. We would like a mix of experienced and new faculty across multiple departments/schools to attend. 15-20 faculty would be good.

Learning Objectives and Outcomes: OGE hopes to facilitate cross-training and sharing of how best to organize a faculty-led study abroad. We would like faculty to share best practices and talk about what went well and what have been challenges when organizing a study abroad. For example, should an interested faculty go with a third party provider or organize the trip on their own, creating their own budget, etc.?
