The primary responsibilities of the successful candidate will be serving as Health Promotion curriculum coordinator, teaching both undergraduate and graduate students, advising undergraduate students, performing service, and conducting research/scholarly activities. Other responsibilities include, but are not limited to, program assessment and service to the department and university as needed. The Department of Kinesiology is one of the largest academic departments at UNCP, and as such, offers many opportunities for the professional growth and advancement of the successful candidate.
