

VMWare Horizon View Setup for Personal Devices

VMWare Horizon View lets faculty, staff and students access a selection of University software from anywhere you have an Internet connection. Access requires installing a client on your device. Upon connecting, it's like sitting at a lab computer on campus.

Usage Notes

Please save all work to an external source. Your Microsoft OneDrive or Google Drive is recommended. Virtual desktops are not permanent storage and are **erased** after your session ends.

If your connection is dropped mid-session, you can resume your session within 30 minutes. After that, you'll be sent to a fresh desktop.

Note: Remember to properly sign-off or shut down the virtual desktop when not in use to ensure optimal functionality for all users.


VMWare Horizon cannot be used while connected to the UNCP network via VPN.

Windows Install

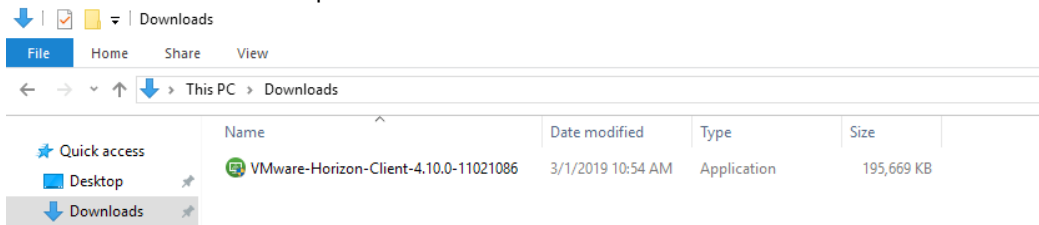
- We recommend downloading the VMWare Horizon Client for Windows, not the Windows 10 UWP version.

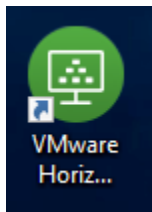

- Once downloaded, open the downloaded file.

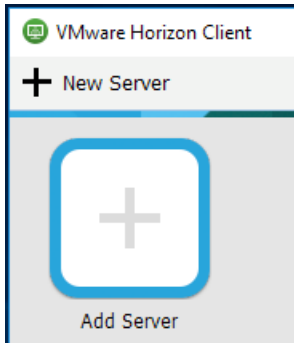


- Select "Agree and Install". When it's done installing, select "Finish".

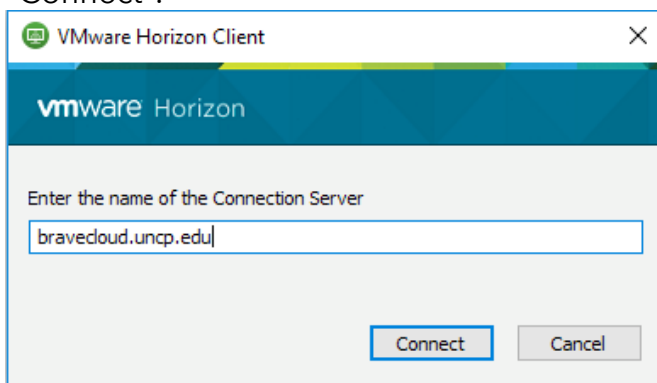
- Open the VMWare Horizon client icon.



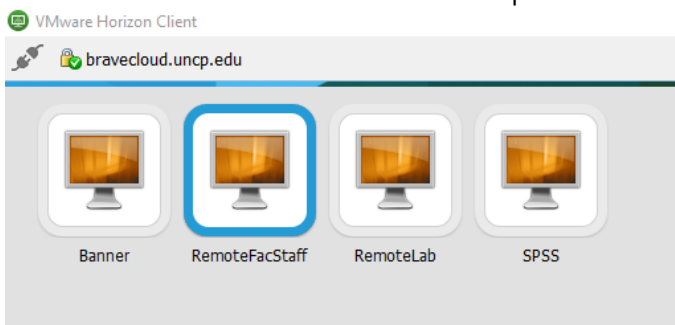
- Select "Add Server".

- Select the **RemoteFacStaff** desktop. It will automatically log in under your profile.

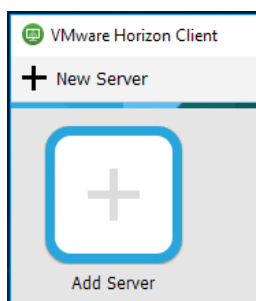


MacOS Install

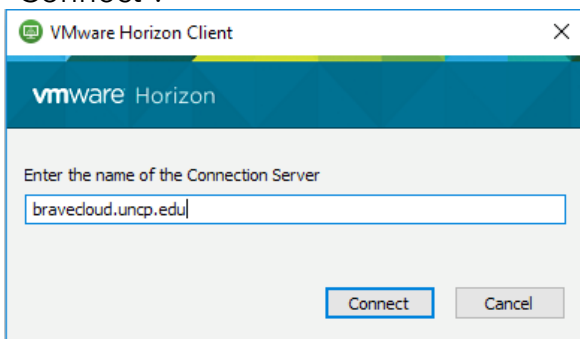
- For Macs, VMWare Horizon can be downloaded and installed via the [VMWare website](#) or installed from the Apple store.
 - If installing via the Apple store, search "VMWare Horizon Client". The application is free.



- Once downloaded and installed, open the VMWare Horizon application.
- Select "Add Server".



- When asked for the Connection Server name, enter: bravecloud.uncp.edu. Select "Connect".



- Use your UNCP **username** and password to log in.
- Select the **RemoteFacStaff** desktop. It will automatically log in under your profile.
