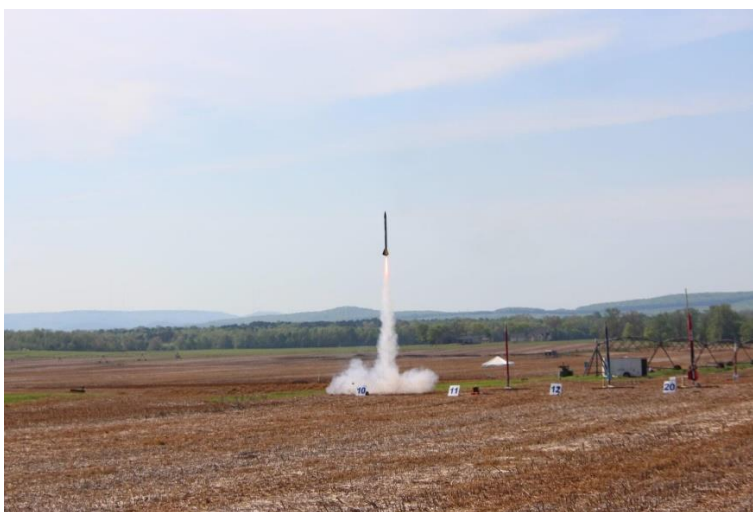

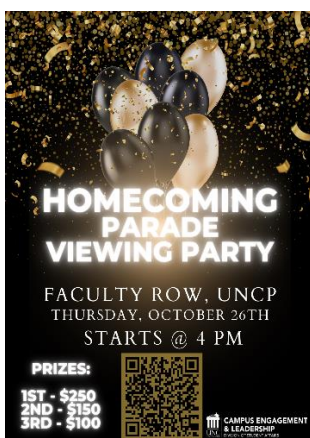
Chemistry and Physics Club Speaker Event
