# BRAVES PACK FOR SUCCESS

Packing for your on-campus home can be a lot of fun, but we recommend packing for success. Residence halls have limited space, and there is no extra storage accessible outside of your designated space.



It is a good idea to explore sharing larger items with your roommate to save space. You should contact your roommate ahead of time to discuss the items that each of you will be responsible for bringing.

Based on room layout, each resident is assigned a bed, a dresser, a desk and chair and a wardrobe or closet. All furnishings must remain in the room throughout the year. Residents are not permitted to remove or store any belongings, outside of their assigned living space, for any purpose.

#### **CLEANING SUPPLIES**

Students are responsible for cleaning their own living space, including common spaces, bedroom, bathroom and kitchen (if applicable) and are expected to purchase their own cleaning supplies and toiletries. Residents in Village and Courtyard Apartments should provide their own cooking/serving utensils.




#### **PETS**

On-campus housing is not conducive to the presence of animals; therefore, the university prohibits pets (including guest and visitor pets) with the exception of freshwater fish, service animals and approved emotional support animals\*. Aquariums under 10 gallons are permitted and are limited to one per room. \*Contact Accessibility Resource Center for more information about the process.



#### **LAUNDRY**

Washers and dryers are available in all on-campus housing. They are coinoperated or your Braves Card may be used. \$1.25 to wash and \$.25 per 15 minutes to dry. We recommend budgeting an average of \$2 per load. A washer and dryer are provided in each unit at Courtyard Apartments at no cost.



#### **APPLIANCES + MORE**

**Prohibited:** Electric scooters, hoverboards, electric frying pans, open coiled appliances, gas and electric grills, charcoal grills, oil lamps, electric or kerosene heaters, deep fat cookers, air fryers, and cooking with or extracting of hot grease are prohibited in the residence hall rooms.

**Permitted:** Hot pots, crock pots, hot plates, coffee makers, tea makers. Items such as irons, hair dryers, curling irons, hair straighteners, electric curlers should not be left plugged in and unattended. Microwaves in student rooms and in common areas must be attended to and monitored when in use.

One per resident; max 4.5 cubic ft.



#### **MICROWAVE**

One per room; max 1200 watts
